Secretary's Scribblings



Well, the first month of the 2023 year is over and it is only 297 days till Christmas. The way the first month has gone it will be here before we know it!!

From our committee meeting on Wednesday 1st February. Long standing member, John Armiger has shifted to Christchurch and now a member of Canterbury Branch.

For those who know Frank Metcalf, he has had a major stroke and is now in full time care in Nelson, and has resigned from the club.

The early MG club are having a rally based at Brayshaw Park from 11th to 14 March. Some assistance for marshals could be needed.

From the Brayshaw Heritage Park Association, the District Council have now taken over the ownership of the park from the Marlborough Heritage Trust, which will be disbanded. The BHPA is operating as agent for Council.

A paper was included in the January Vintage Viewpoint to do with the change in the VCC Constitution, which I hope you all read. We had a discussion about this, as well as putting it to the 60 people at smoko. Our view is that as far as makeup of the Board, we go with option 1, National president, Club Captain North Island and South Island, and 4 regional representatives elected to these positions for 3 years with a maximum of 2 terms. Also, a Sec/treasurer would be appointed along with Registrar and Beaded Wheels editor. A suggestion that these positions be positions reporting to the board but would not be members of the Board.

This would give an elected board of 7 people.

The new rules do not allow branches to be involved in executive meetings as they are now, so would lose the ability to have twice yearly meetings, but the branches will have a direct representative on the Board.

There was also a clause in the document about membership, and maybe like-minded clubs or groups becoming members of the VCC. This would be the organisation, not individual members as members.

The Discipline process was in the document, and we felt that the VCC Constitution should include a robust process for this, and the branches tag along with this. There is no point having two different discipline processes, one for the VCC and one for each Branch.

To remain Incorporated, or unincorporate. We say our branches need to remain Incorporated as if we are not there are many fishhooks to deal with.

This is to be discussed at the Executive meeting in March. Once this process has gone through the rewrite, branches will be able to have further say down the track. Must be completed by end of 2025, as each organisation has to re-register by December of that year.

Another discussion paper to be talked about in March is about Long Service Awards. Several proposals have been put forward about changes going forward. There are 7 options, and we agreed with option 3, which is Awards are vetted and processed by National Office, but all awards are presented at Branch level by chairman.

Our branch put a remit to the AGM in Greymouth about 6 years ago on this and it was shot down in flames, but we agree with this.

The other clause which we also agree with is 5, where national office hold the badge stocks and certificates, but the branch takes over the awarding and processing of all long service awards.

To us, this seems sensible, as the branch secretary does all the paperwork for these now, and with the new system of having access to all branch members online, it makes it very easy to check up how long each person has been a member.

Option 6 was that all awards except the 50-year award be scrapped. We suggest that the 35-year award be scrapped.

Another item up for discussion is the VCC National Day. Currently over the past 6 years the Charity has been Cancer Society. We would like to see this changed, and the Charity of our choice would be Hospice.

Our Branch has been awarded the National Vintage Only Rally in 2024, and the National Veteran rally in 2025.

We need to put dates to these, and we have decided that we need to incorporate Heritage Day in these rallies, so the Vintage rally will be from 5th to 8th February 2024, and the Veteran rally, similar, 5th to 8th February 2025. These are mid-week dates.

There has been some concern about smoking and vaping around the Club rooms and museum. We will install signs stating NO SMOKING OR VAPING within these areas.

Have a great month of Heritage Motoring.
